



# **Trinity Sunday**



Pastoral Reflections by Rev. Wilson Andrade, CSC The book of Exodus gives us a beautiful image of God: "*The LORD, the LORD, a merciful and gracious God, slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity.*" (EX: 34:6) This is a consoling image to reflect upon as sometimes our images of God are misguided or misunderstood. Most of us believe in a God who punishes us for our sins – a dreadful frightening image of God. But the scriptures present to us God as merciful, gracious, slow to anger, rich in kindness and faithfulness. It is Jesus Christ who reveals to us such an image of God – as he says in the Gospel: "*God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life.*" (Jn. 3:16) Our Christian God is Trinitarian – One God in three Persons. God is the Loving *Father* who cares for us.

God has loved us through the mission and the person of Jesus Christ, *the Son of God* and strengthens us through *the Holy Spirit*.

Our God is present in our lives. There is one God and we belong to God. We are God's Family. God is the Creator and Merciful Father: God is the only begotten Son, eternal wisdom incarnate, who died and rose from the dead for us; God is the Holy Spirit who moves the cosmos and all human history. In the Creed we profess: We believe in the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. There are three persons in Trinity, yet, they are one divine unity. The three divine persons are united and become one community who work for our salvation. St. Paul today invites us to call God as "Abba! Father!" All who are led by the spirit of God are sons and daughters of God. It is the Holy Spirit bearing witness with our spirit that we are children of God. We are the Children of God, so we live like our one true loving God, the Father, and the Son and the Holy Spirit.
