The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Pastoral Reflections by Rev. Wilson Andrade, CSC

Today we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi, the feast of the most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. This feast is the hallmark of our faith which we celebrate daily and on Sundays during the Eucharist.

Today in the Gospel Jesus reminds us: "... this is my Body... this is my Blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many." How do we prepare ourselves to receive Jesus in the Body and Blood of Christ? Let us



receive Holy Communion with fervent love and respect -- not merely as a matter of routine.

In the Second Reading, we hear about the Blood of Christ, "...who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without blemish to God...", thus obtaining eternal redemption so that we may receive the promised eternal inheritance.

By receiving Holy Communion we become Christ-bearers as Mary was, with the duty of conveying Christ to others at home and in the workplace, through love, mercy, forgiveness and humble and sacrificial service.

As we celebrate this great feast of faith, let us worship what St. Thomas Aquinas did not hesitate to call, "the greatest miracle that Christ ever worked on earth My Body...... My Blood". Before the greatness of this mystery, let us exclaim with St. Augustine, "O Sacrament of devotion! O Sign of unity! O Bond of charity!" Let us also repeat St. Thomas Aquinas' prayer of devotion in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament: "O Sacrament most holy! O Sacrament divine! All praise and all thanksgiving be every moment Thine!
