JULY – Dedicated to seniors

May 18th-20st: 10 members of Native Peoples' Mission attended the 20th St. Kateri Healing and Reconciliation Conference in Ottawa.

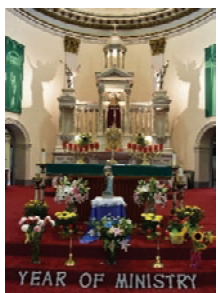
JUNE
