# 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary time: JANUARY 20, 2019 CELEBRATING THE YEAR OF CARE FOR CREATION

#### January 2019 Water Fr. Wilson Andrade, CSC

Water is the precious natural resource of God's creation. Bible mentions that water is one of the first creation of God. "Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters" (Genesis 1: 2) Since the beginning, the water is used to give beautiful images for life and rebirth (Garden of Eden), cleansing (Noah), blessings and judgement (Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel), Faithfulness and Protection (Psalms). "For I will pour water on the thirsty land, and streams on the dry ground; I will pour out my Spirit on your offspring, and my blessing on your descendants" (Is. 44:3) and the famous Psalm 23 speaks about the Divine Shepherd will lead us to "near restful waters."



In the New Testament Jesus echoes and identifies "streams of living water" will flow within those believe in him and to the Samaritan woman, Jesus declares: "I am the Living water giving all eternal life." (Jn 4).

Only once you carried your own water you will value every drop of it.



Later in the Tradition, the Church invites all by saying "let us draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water." (Hebrews 10:22). As believers and Christians we are reborn by the waters of Baptism and every time we enter the church, and dip our fingers into the bowl of Holy Water, we are reminded of our baptismal commitment.

During the month of January we take time to reflect on Water, precious and essential gift of God, let us give thanks to God and also make efforts not to waste water. We also pray for those who do not have enough water

in their region so the leaders of the nations may help to provide water for every living creature of God.

We pray that let no one will be thirsty due to lack of water, rather fully satisfied in the conscious use of water and in the end of our earthly life, we may join in the rich feast of heaven where our heart's deepest desire began and fulfilled as predicted by John:

"I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. To the thirsty I will give water without cost from the spring of the water of life" (Rev. 21: 6).
