Archdiocese of Toronto Update: Canada's Food Guide 2019

For the first time since 2007, Health Canada has introduced a new food guide with updated nutritional recommendations. The new food guide focuses on eating more vegetables, drinking more water, choosing whole grains rather than refined flour, and emphasizes plant-based proteins. Gone are the days of the four separate sections (grain products, fruits and vegetables, meat and alternatives, milk and alternatives) and the suggested portion sizes. Instead, the guide features a plate half-filled with fruits and vegetables and the other side of the plate is split in half with protein-rich foods and whole grains. It encourages eating a variety of healthy foods each day. The federal government recommends that Canadians do the following to eat well and live well:

- Be mindful of your eating habits
- Eat meals with others
- Limit highly-processed foods
- Cook more oftenRead food labels
- Enjoy your food
- Beware of food marketing
- Choose protein foods that come from plants more often.
