1. Learn more about climate change.

In *Laudato Si'*, Pope Francis reminds us that we have a responsibility to care for the Earth—our common home. Take time to read and reflect on it, share it, and implement its suggestions in your community.

2. Advocate for our Earth and its people.

Ask Congress to protect people most harmed by climate change. You can be an advocate for those who often are not heard, by asking your senators and representative to support funding for poverty-focused international assistance, particularly the Green Climate Fund, and full implementation of the Paris Climate Change Accord.

3. Plant a tree in your community.

God calls us to be stewards of the Earth. What you do in your community can have a big impact on the world. Trees clean the air and provide oxygen. They help us prevent soil erosion and can conserve energy. They are also beautiful. Organize your own tree planting or network with: www.arborday.org; www.rainforesttrust.org

4. Support farmers and their families.

Farming projects help hundreds of thousands of people feed their families, work toward self-sufficiency and steward the Earth's resources for future generations. By giving a bag of fertilizer, for instance, you are helping farmers nourish soil, reap better harvest
