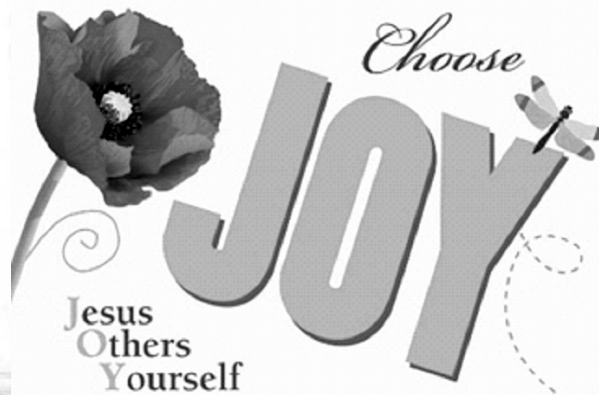

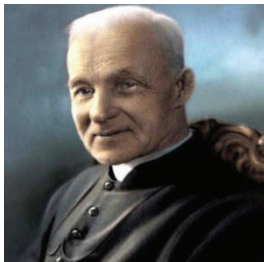
CELEBRATING THE YEAR OF JOY

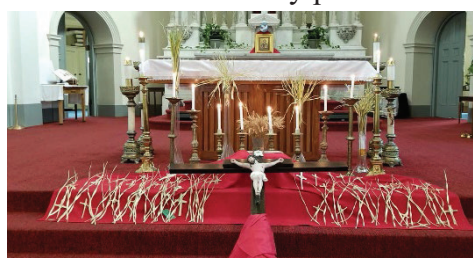
MARCH - Season of Lent - Bible Project and Sacrament of Reconciliation
