Dear Members of St. Ann Parish Community,

Thank you for your commitment and generosity in helping our Parish community to be active and alive. During the Parish Closure (Mid-March to late June) we, with the help of dedicated volunteers of St. Ann Food Bank, served 4,800 individuals, especially seniors and families. Since our opening in June, we are proud to have ensured a safe environment for worship in the Church building through the hard work of many volunteers. In order to connect with everyone and make our Liturgical celebration accessible we installed ne camera and continue to live stream our Sunday 10 30 am morning mass.

We would like to draw your attention to our current finical situation, as expected, we have a decline of \$20,27.20 in our operating revenue. We have been effective in our operating expenses as we reduced the cost to \$16,883.99 compared to 2019. We are helped by the Archdiocesan subsidy and 75% of CEWS. From September onwards CEWS will be reduced, leaving us with an operating deficit, that can lead our finances into a difficult situation.

In this period of uncertainty, we ask you to help us to be effective in our financial management. We ask for your suggestions how we can increase our offertory collections and donations. Please do consider switching to Pre-Authorized Giving or check the website for making online donations. We greatly appreciate if you could request your family and friends to help us during these uncertain times.

We, sincerely express our gratitude for your commitment, ongoing support and generosity.
