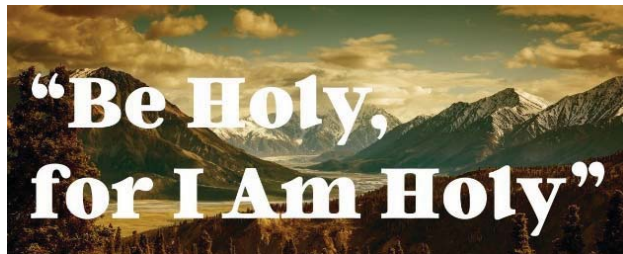

2021: The Call to Holiness



We would like to dedicate the new Liturgical year of 2020 – 2021 as the **Year of Call to Holiness**. Holiness is closely linked to joyfulness and blessedness. During this year of call to Holiness, may be a time for each one of us to listen to God speaking to us in the Scriptures or in the silence of our hearts, to renew our baptismal promises and to actively participate in the Sacraments of the Church

and lastly by our Sacred service to others, we can bring God's holiness and proclaim it to the whole world.

**Call to Holiness: Month of February: Marriage, Single and Consecrated Life**

In 2014, on the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Proclamation of the *Lumen Gentium*, Pope Francis in his address to the consecrated life, he invited all faithful to reflect on the universal Call to Holiness. He explained some of the Aims of the Year of Consecrated Life is “to look to the past with gratitude, to live in the present with passion, and to embrace the future with hope.” He invited everyone “to wake up the world, since the distinctive sign of consecrated life is prophecy. “Radical evangelical living is not only for religious: it is demanded of everyone.



But religious follow the Lord in a special way, in a prophetic way.” This is the priority that is needed right now: “to be prophets who witness to how Jesus lived on this earth... a religious must never abandon prophecy” We signed in our baptism to become saints.... Let us help another on our call to holiness.

During this year of call to Holiness, I invite you to reflect on your consecrated life. We are consecrated in our baptism and received the call to Holiness. Let us keep awake and wake up the world with justice, peace and love. In a concrete way, I invite you to take time to reflect on your life, your faith journey of life, if possible to read a book and go for a retreat or spiritual direction.

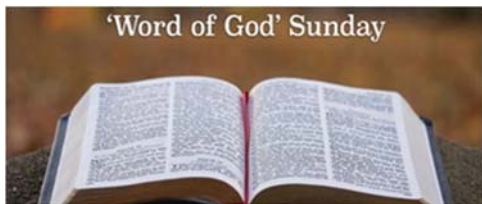
**Family Prayer – 2021: “Lord, Teach us to pray”**
