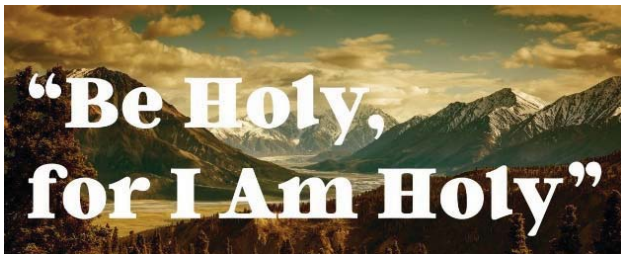

2021: The Call to Holiness

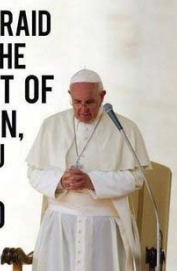

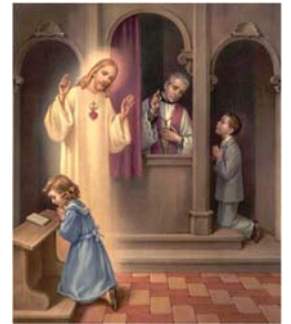

**Celebrating the Year of St. Joseph**

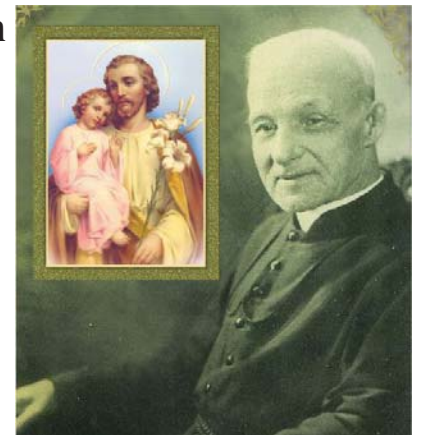
10 days Novena in honor of St. Joseph and Feast Day celebration

**Tax Receipts for 2020**



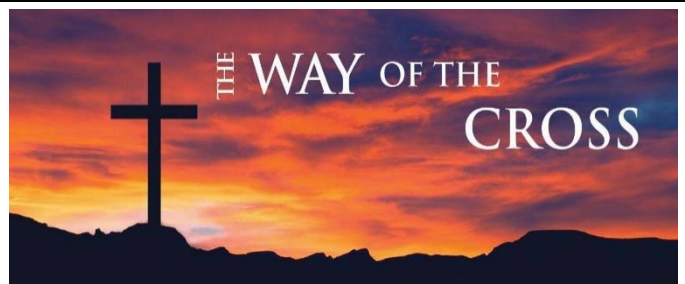
