OCTOBER

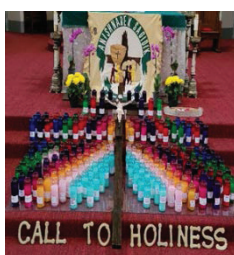
October 7th: We promoted Family Prayer on of Our Lady of the Rosary.

December 24th: Celebration of Christmas Festive Mass with Native Peoples' Mission

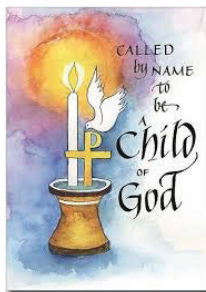
December 25th: Feast Day Eucharist in celebration of the Solemnity of Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ.

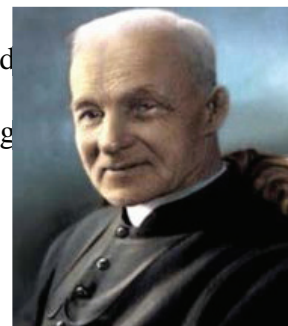
JANUARY

FEBRUARY



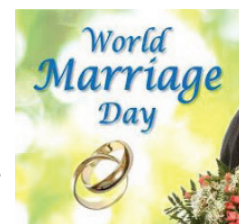
February 2nd: World Day of Prayer for Consecrated life

February 27th: Marriage Sunday: 40 couples renewed their vows celebrating a total of 1245 years of marriage.



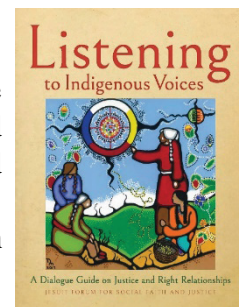
February 27th: The Ignite Youth Ministry of St. Patrick's church held a session on Indigenous Spirituality – *Pathways to Reconciliation*.
