## NATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER IN SOLIDARITY WITH INDIGENOUS PEOPLES

The Canadian Catholic Aboriginal Council has



released a prayer of thanksgiving for families for the National day of Prayer in Solidarity of Indigenous Peoples. The Aboriginal Council and the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops have promoted

the annual National Day of prayer since 2002. It is celebrated on December 12, the memorial of our Lord of Guadalupe, whom Pope Pius XXII proclaim patroness of the Americas in 1946. The devotion dates to 1531 when Blessed Mother appeared as an Aztec princess to a humble Aboriginal peasant, saint Juan Diego, at a place called the Hill of Tepeyac, which eventually became part of Villa de Guadalupe, a suburb of Mexico City. With the Native Peoples Mission, we continue to pray and promote healing with the Indigenous peoples of Canada. All of us need to engage in healthy dialogue to become aware of the process of truth and reconciliation. #### GREEN CORNER

Pope Francis writes: "The earth's resources are also being plundered because of short-sighted approaches to the economy, commerce and production. The loss of forests and woodlands entails the loss of species which may constitute extremely important resources in the future, not only for food but also for curing disease and other uses. Different species contain genes which could be key resources in years ahead for meeting human needs and regulating environmental problems." Laudato si #32. Having a Green Christmas does not need to be a challenge! We can protect the biodiversity of our world, which is God's gift to us, in a number of different ways!

\*When we use wrapping paper to wrap our Christmas gifts, we in effect promote the cutting down of trees and the degradation of forests and we also create more garbage and pollution! Christmas wrapping paper cannot be recycled! Instead of using wrapping paper consider using a cloth bag, one of last year's recycled Christmas gift bags, decorated newsprint, or plain brown paper. Trees are homes to many of our bird friends, insects and animals.

\*Make a gift to nature this Christmas by hanging a bird feeder or better still give a gift of a bird feeder to a child in your family.

\*Engage in a Christmas Bird Count! Choose a day close to Christmas and count the varieties of birds you see in your yard or on a walk. Encourage family and friends to do the same and compare your sightings.

\*Hang a string of popcorn strung by children of the family outdoors as a treat for the birds and small creatures in your area.
