On this First Sunday after Christmas, the Church invites all of us to reflect on the beauty of the Holy Family. It is through meditating on the Holy Family that we begin to learn how we are called to live in our own homes. St. John

Paul II says that "the Holy Family is the beginning of countless other holy families."

The Holy Family teaches us how to work towards

holiness through our daily family life. They led a life that was to all appearances, the same as that of their neighbours, a life that was important, not because of the material things they did but because of the love that they put into these things."

Essentially, the Holy Family did ordinary things with extraordinary love.
